Dr.T.K.Murthy – doyen of Mridangam artists, made his debut at the tender age of eleven. During his illustrious career spanning 80 years he has accompanied in more than 15,000 concerts and accompanied eminent artists over five generations of gurusishya parampara. He also has the distinction of accompanying Bharat Ratna Smt. M.S.Subbulakshmi for over forty years. He was conferred the Honorary Doctorate by the Arizona University, USA and Sangeetha Kalanidhi by the Music Academy. He is the only artiste in the world to have composed and played Mohra and Korvai for 35 Talas, 72 Melakartha Talas and also for 108 Talas. Despite his advanced age of 90 years he still performs with the same zeal and zest. He lives in Madipakkam in a street named after him. Naadhabrahmam salutes the great legend while conferring "Laya Brahma" on Dr.T.K.Murthy

Smt. N.S.Jayalakshmi popularly known as Kalakshetra Jaya teacher is a prime disciple of the legendary Smt. Rukmani Devi Arundale. As a Bharatanatyam and Kathakali exponent, her study of Shastra both in theory and practice is in-depth. She has travelled the world over and has served in several Indian and overseas universities and colleges; as an examiner, selection board member, thesis evaluator and in advisory boards. An erudite scholar in Bharatanatyam and academics she was conferred with numerous titles and awards that include Kalaimamani by the Government of Tamil Nadu, Acharya Choodamani by Krishna Gana Sabha, Best Guru award by Narada Gana Sabha and Sangeetha Kalacharya by the Music Academy. Her notable students to name a few are Padma Bhushan Sri V.P.Dhananjayan, Smt. Shantha Dhanajayan and Ms. Leela Samson. On conferring the title of "Nrithya Kovida" to Ms. N.S.Jayalakshmi, in fact, brings more laurels to the Naadabrahmam award.

Chitravina N Ravikiran, hailed as the greatest slide instrumentalist in the world today, is a revolutionary composer in world music. He made headlines as the world's youngest prodigy at a tender age of two, presented vocal concerts at the age of five, chitravina recitals at the age of eleven and performed non-stop for 24 hours at the age of eighteen. Ravikiran's original concepts and inventions have revolutionized not only Indian music but have also impacted world music at the global level. Ravikiran has collaborated with top world artists and orchestras including the BBC Philharmonic. He founded the North American Melharmonic Orchestra (NAMO) and the International Foundation for Carnatic Music (IFCM). Ravikiran is the youngest musician to have received the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award from the President of India. His numerous titles include Sangeeta Choodamani from Krishna Gana Sabha. Naadhabrahmam is very much honoured in felicitating Chitravina N. Ravikiran with a citation "Tantri Vadya Brahma".

Smt. Subathra Sudarshan born in Colombo, Sri Lanka, was drawn into dancing as a passion at an early age of four and blossomed into an exemplary dancer under the tutelage of Naatayaacharyas Shri V.P. Dhananjayan and Smt. Shanta Dhananjayan. An outstanding academician she is also adept in playing the Veena. Her excellent dance skills enabled her to participate in International Dance Festivals in Europe, London, South America, Africa and Canada. She had the opportunity to perform for Queen Elizabeth and Lady Diana. Smt. Subathra Sudarshan is the Director of Bharathakala Naatya Academy, Johns Creek, GA (USA) that was established in 2005 for promoting Bharatanatyam. The distinction of the school lies in the fact that the students not only learn dance but are also made aware of some of the pressing issues faced in the world, the suffering undergone by the less fortunate people and other problems which they are normally shielded from due to their sheltered upbringing. Her superb choreography enabled her school to achieve numerous awards. Naadhabrahmam on conferring Smt. Subathra Sudarshan with the title "Nrithya Sevika" enhances the glory of the award.

Shri. J. Suryanarayana Murthy, who hails from a traditional Kuchipudi Bhagavata family, initially joined Kalakshetra but the Dhananjayans' Bharatakalanjali moulded him completely into a fine male Bharatanaatyam artiste. After accomplishing and imbibing the best of the Dhananjayans, Murthy completed his diploma course in Kalakshetra and joined the institution as a teacher. He is presenting one of his own productions "Nalamtarum Navagraha" with students trained by him.

He has been performing Sangita Upanyasams and bhajans at various places throughout the country and has been awarded the title "Bagavatha Kainkaryamani" by the Travancore Maharaj (King of Travancore) himself. He formed the Vittoba Bhajan Mandali and is training a number of people in singing Abhangas, particularly in Varakari Sampradaya, which is his special liking and mastery.




